I appreciate it's been tricky to get the right balance of school opening times etc but the only one criticism I have is school entry. At the start of term the gates to enter early years Playground were open prior to the 8.50 start time. I thought this was really well managed and felt I could socially distance from other parents. However, recently the gates haven't opened until 8.50 and therefore created quite a large queue of people trying to get down the narrow path. This lead to a bottle neck especially with parents trying to get past the queue of parents at reception/nursery. I have found myself entering the gates later and later to try and avoid this. I would ask the school that they consider reopening the gates prior to 8.50 to allow for a much lighter flow of parents/pupils rather than everyone entering at once.
